Maths

Today we are going to investigate cubed numbers.

A cubed number is made when we multiply a number by itself twice.

For example, 2^3 is the same as $2 \times 2 \times 2 (= 8)$

2^3	$2^3 + 3^3$
3^3	$3^3 + 4^3$
4^3	$5^3 + 4^3$
5^3	$6^3 + 4^3$
6^3	$7^3 + 6^3$
7^3	$8^3 + 7^3$

Now try this challenge:

True or false?

$$7^2 + 2^3 = 49$$

True or false?

$$8^2 + 3^3 = 91$$

True or false?

$$7^2 - 2^3 = 41$$
