



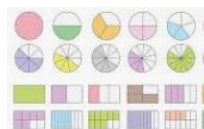
Curriculum Overview – Year 3 Summer Term



Maths

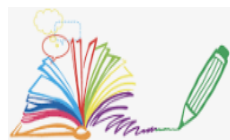
In Maths this term, we will be challenging ourselves with further work on fractions, along with money, time, shape and statistics.
