

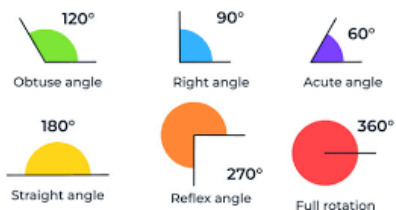


Curriculum Overview – Summer Term – Year 5 – Eureka!
