



# Curriculum Overview – Summer – Year 6 – Crime and Punishment




## Maths

Shape - Recognise angles where they meet at a point, are on a straight line, or are vertically opposite, and find missing angles. Draw given angles and measure them in degrees.

Position and Direction – describe positions on the full coordinate grid (all our quadrants).
