



Curriculum Overview – Autumn– Year 1/2



Maths

In maths our learning will be focussing on place value; addition and subtraction; and properties of shape.

Before half-term we will be mastering understanding of numbers to 20 we will build on this after half-term to work with numbers to 100

Science

Our science learning will be about animals including humans. This will include learning about important parts of our bodies. We will also be comparing the features of other animals and look at differences between animal groups.

English Writing

In writing we will be using a story-based approach analysing stories to use as both models and stimulus for our own writing. Our stories are The Dot, Little Red Riding Hood, Stanley Stick, Puffin Peter, The Way Back Home (film), Gruffalo Crumble, Mr Big and The Jolly Christmas Postman.

English Reading

For reading we will be continuing with our daily phonics sessions and children's independent reading will be linked to that. We will also be reading for both pleasure and entertainment.

Reading with your children is important – as well as them reading to you, remember it is as important for you to read to them.

Reading books will be changed weekly, but books should be in school every day.

Our PE days are Wednesday and Friday.

We are hoping to visit another local school to compare similarities between schools.

In Autumn 2 we will be making windmills – we will need paper cups, bendy straws and cocktail sticks, any donations of these would be appreciated.

Geography

In geography we will be learning about our school, where it is and how it fits into our community.

History

For history we will be looking at how we make history ourselves.
