

Curriculum Overview – Spring – YEAR 5



Maths

We will be continuing multiplication and division with formal methods and then moving on to fractions, decimals and percentages with converting between them. After half term, we will be concentrating on perimeter and area and statistics.

Science

Having learnt about properties of materials last term, we are learning about what happens to materials when they change state this term. After February we shall learn about animals and their habitats.

English Writing

Persuasive and balanced arguments are the focus of our writing this first half-term before revisiting our narrative skills.

English Reading

We will continue our reading using the skills of VIPERS (Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, explanation, retrieval, summarising and sequencing. Next half term, we will be reading *The London Eye Mystery*.
