



Curriculum Overview – Spring Term – Year 6



Maths

This term all our units will be for two weeks. The following topics will be covered this Spring Term: Ratio, Algebra, Decimals, Fractions, Percentages, Area, Perimeter and Statistics.

We will also be offering booster Maths interventions with Mr O'Callaghan, Mrs Twyman and Mrs Flynn to support the children in their learning and ensure they are confident in all areas of the Curriculum. Please keep practicing your timetables as well as this is a Golden Ticket for Maths!

Science

This term we are looking at:

Animals, including Humans- We will find out about the human circulatory system, think about how diet and exercise affect our bodies and describe how nutrients and water are transported within the body.

Light- We will explore light, how it travels and how that enables us to see, as well as use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

English Writing

Our focus for this half term is writing to discuss travel and writing to inform.

English Reading

We continue the year reading a range of texts to develop our comprehension skills. We will be learning to use Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval and Summarising skills (VIPERS).

We will also be practicing SATS Questions so we are prepared for the upcoming papers in Spring. We will be looking at how we answer the questions and how we can retrieve the answers from the given text.
