



Curriculum Overview – Spring – Year 1/2



Maths

In maths our learning will be focussing on addition and subtraction within 100; multiplication and division including doubling and halving, grouping and sharing and writing multiplication sentences; length and height and statistics using tally charts, tables and pictograms.

Science

Our science learning will be about Everyday materials. We will learning how to distinguish between an object and the material it is made from. We will be learning to identify common materials and their properties as well as how to use their knowledge of materials to make best use of materials for specific purposes.

English Writing

In writing we will continue to use a mostly book based curriculum which includes studying The Last Noo Noo by Jill Murphy; Here Comes Mr Postmouse by Marianne Dubuc; Taking Flight, a film unit about a young boy and his wagon.

English Reading

For reading we will be continuing with our daily phonics sessions and children's independent reading will be linked to that. We will also be reading for both pleasure and entertainment.

Reading with your children is important – as well as them reading to you, remember it is as important for you to read to them.

Reading books will be changed weekly, but books should be in school every day.
