Maths

We start this term focussing on fractions of amounts before we move on to learning about money, telling the time, shapes and statistics. We will continue to revise, practise and embed our number work, including addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills



English Writing

In writing this term, we will be writing a persuasive advert, persuading people to visit ancient Egypt, and learning how to write a balanced argument. After half term we focus our writing on 'Charlotte's Web.

English Reading

We will continue our reading using the skills of VIPERS (Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, explanation, retrieval, summarising and sequencing. We will be reading Charlotte's Web after half term

Science

In Science this half term we will be learning about plants. We will look at the function of the parts of the plant, how they grow best and investigate the way in which water is transported in plants.
