If you think the first thing that happened was 'C' then in your book write 1 = C etc. Remember in History how we can use the dates to help us.

A = The Scott Institute at Cambridge University was set up in 1920.

B = Captain Scott and his crew arrived on Ross Island in Antarctica.

C = Captain Scott wrote his last diary entry.

D = The Scott Expedition set off from Britain in June 1910 on the Terra Nova.

E = Amunsden beats Scott and his team to the South Pole.

F = Captain Scott and his crew faced a fierce storm in New Zealand.

G = On 20th March 1912 there was a fierce blizzard.
