Here are some things you could try...

When we went to Tring Museum, one of the animals we saw was the Emperor Penguin, they live in Antarctica.

Can you create a fact-file about Emperor Penguins? Find out how tall they are, what they weigh, what they eat and a fact you think would surprise us!

It can get really cold in Antarctica; the average temperature is minus 57°C. Here is a link to some experiments you could try that use ice.
