Today we are going to continue to write instructions. I would like you to write instructions for playing a game today, this could be a board game, a computer game, an outside game or even a game you have created.

Remember that we need to make sure you have a list of any equipment that you need and then write out the instructions in the right order using imperative verbs.

Here is my example for playing hopscotch.

<u>Equipment</u>

Hopscotch squares A small stone for each player

- 1. Stand next to the number one on the hopscotch
- 2. Throw a stone onto a number
- 3. Jump on the numbers, starting with one
- 4. Stop when you get to your stone's number
- 5. Pick up the stone
- 6. Keep jumping on the numbers until you get to the end
- 7. Turn around and jump back to the start
